

Guide for 2019 OBIYR Registration – Tips & FAQs

Information needed to register:

- A valid CLUBSPOT user login. Create an account with CLUBSPOT before registration to save time; or it can be done during the registration process (not recommended).
- US Sailing number (valid through December 30, 2019 see notes below)
- Sail number (if not known at this time, please write "TBD" and update later)
- Credit card (all major cards accepted). <u>Have a back-up card ready just in case</u>.
- Contact phone & email address
- Emergency contact information

Registering a double handed boat (C420s):

- The skipper is responsible for registering double handed boats (C420s)
- The skipper will register the skipper and crew
- The skipper will need the crew's US Sailing number and emergency contact information
- The skipper can register for a skipper only and add the crew at a later time

Registering two children at once:

Some people have asked how they can register two sailors at the same time. CLUBSPOT requires registering one child at a time, however two people can be logged-in to the same account at once, each processing a registration. Therefore, if you are worried about quickly securing spots for both sailors, we recommend that you have open two separate windows to process two different registrations simultaneously (using the same login details). Or you can have two people logged-in simultaneously each registering a sailor under the same account.

US Sailing Number:

Please note that OBIYR registration will require a valid US Sailing number. <u>Type the number only</u> (do not use "#"). If your US Sailing membership expires between now and December 30, 2019, you will <u>not</u> be permitted to register for OBIYR. In order to prevent this from happening, please renew your registration with US Sailing prior to OBIYR registration. Your credit card will be charged; however, the new membership will not become effective until the current year lapses. You will be permitted to renew your US Sailing membership during the OBIYR registration, but this will delay the OBIYR registration process (not recommended). Foreign competitors are not required to have a US Sailing membership.

Waivers

Once your OBIYR registration is complete via CLUBSPOT, you (and your crew) will receive an email with a link to sign an electronic waiver. At this point you will have secured your spot at the regatta for the time being, but your registration is <u>NOT</u> complete. Parents or guardians of sailors under 18 years of age must read and sign the electronic waiver in order for the registration to be complete. Click in the signature area on the form and follow the prompt to provide your electronic signature.

Facebook Messenger

CLUBSPOT has integrated with Facebook Messenger. If you would like to receive communications about the regatta in Facebook Messenger, please make sure to check this option during the registration process.
